It is in the Civil Parish Of Killeavey and the Barony of Orior Upper.

Area: - 487.08 Hectares -1.88 Square Miles

Historical Monuments :

Moyry (Moyra) Castle -

Moyry Castle was built in the 17th Century to guard the strategic mountain pass known as Moyry Pass or "The Gap of the North" The Castle was built by Lord Mountjoy to secure route between Ulster and Leinster

Lissacashel Ruins "Carrickbroad Cashel"

Privileged that this Stone Ring Fort " lios an Chaisil" is located on my Father's farmland . Cashel consists of an oval enclosure 34m N-S X 40cm E-W. It is defined by a tumbled Stone wall and is well preserved on North and South Side.
